History

The pictures here were taken at the dedication of Harwinton's new Veterans War Memorial on 19 October 2024. The memorial, which is located on the Town Green, replaces the old memorial which has been moved to the green between the Town Hall and Library. The old memorial honored Harwinton veterans that served during WWI, WWII, Korea and Vietnam. The new memorial covers all wars in which Harwinton veterans served from the French and Indian war to the War on Terror.

The new large, circular monument is almost entirely granite featuring a large open space in the center with granite compass on the center floor. Six plinths, on which are engraved the wars and veterans, are in a semicircle around the periphery of the monument. A new 40' flagpole is located halfway between the 6 plinths on the north end of the monument. Lighting has been installed between the plinths, along the entryway and under the flagpole to illuminate the flag at night. The project took 16 years from brainchild to completion. Come visit!
